As we have previously communicated, both middle schools are in the process of transitioning to a standards based grading and reporting system which will align us with our elementary counterparts that adopted the practice last year. This year our district teaching and learning department will be sending out quarterly communications to help families better understand this transition, with the first one coming towards the end of the month.

We are excited about the impact this system will have on further promoting student learning and growth. This academic year is considered a pilot year for the middle schools with the 2016-17 academic year being the time we will by fully implementing the approach. Much of the work is being done behind the scenes as we prepare for next year, but our new practices are certainly starting to surface in our daily practice as teachers begin to pilot.
